By emulating the act of Andrew, the first Brothers Andrew reached out to men in rooming houses, providing Bibles and inviting them to come to church for worship, to hear the Holy Scriptures and to accept Jesus into their lives.

Our Rule of Life is a commitment to these three disciplines:

**THE DISCIPLINE OF PRAYER:** to pray daily for the spread of Christ's Kingdom, especially among men and youth, and for God's blessings upon the labors of the Brotherhood.

**THE DISCIPLINE OF STUDY:** to study the Holy Scriptures regularly and the teachings of the Church, to attain a better understanding of how to follow Christ and bring others into his Kingdom.

**THE DISCIPLINE OF SERVICE:** to make continuous efforts, week by week, to bring others nearer to Christ through his Church.
